## Living Accomodation

The hostel is under the direct supervision of the principal and looked after by hostel wardens and matrons. Every effort is made to ensure that the boarders are kept comfortable, healthy, and happy.

- 1) The matrons give boarders of class one of four a bath regularly and the boarders of class 5 to 7 take bath themselves under the supervision of the wardens. Senior boarders are expected to take care of their personal cleanliness by themselves.
- 2) Nails are trimmed regularly.
- 3) Bed sheets and pillow cover are changed once a week.
- 4) Shoes are polished everyday.
- 5) In case of small children the matrons put hair oil, comb the hair and help the children to dress up.
- 6) Students must wear proper school uniform and should be neat and clean.
- 7) They take care of the school and personal belongings themselves.

## Hostel Rules and Regulation

- 1) Students must wear proper uniforms at both school and non-school hours as prescribed by the institution. They are not allowed to bring unwanted dresses, belts, boots and eatables inside the school area.
- 2) Students must speak English and follow the school's rules and regulations.
- 3) Any kind of valuables as gold ring, bangles, chain and lockets are not allowed. long clumsy and scruffy hairstyle, earrings are strictly prohibited.
- 4) Students can go home on the day mentioned in the school calendar. Authorized guardians of the child will only be allowed to visit the child or take him/her on holidays.
- 5) Parents who have any complaints, suggestions or recommendations to make regarding their children's health, the food in the school, their children's performance in studies or any thing else are free to meet the teacher concerned or the principal and lodge their complaints or suggestions.

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## Introduction

## Admission

- 1) Two months before the end of the academic session, parents can acquire a standard form along with the prospectus, which they can obtain from the Account Section of the school by paying Rs. 200. Filled in forms should be submitted within 7 days with marks sheet, and a transfer certificate from the previous school and birth certificate to the Admission section/ Account section.
- 2) Students are called for entrance test followed by an interview. A detailed description of the Entrance test is made available later in the course of time.
- 3) After 3 days of the Entrance Test, names of successful candidates and those of the waiting list will be put up on the school notice board.
- 4) Selected students must be admitted within ten days from the publication of the results of the entrance test.
- 5) Written test will be given in major subjects (Nepali, English, Mathematics & Science). Questions will be based on the standard of the class in which the candidate is presently studying. (For further details about the admission procedure parents are requested to contact the School office.)
